



MAJOR ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

THE PRESIDENT'S SCHOLARSHIP - \$20,000

Eligibility **New for 2020 * Interim transcripts due: February 20, 2020** Applications due: April 6, 2020.

- a) enrolling at KPU in a four year program
- b) 80% average in English Studies 12 and 3 other academic Grade 12 courses, or the equivalent of a 3.67 transfer GPA on a minimum of 24 transferable university credits
- c) demonstrated leadership, community involvement and volunteerism

Conditions

- a) registration in a minimum of 12 undergraduate credits per semester
- b) required to maintain a minimum CGPA of 3.0 for the duration of the award period

Value & Quantity

Fall Semester Intake: Four awards; \$5000 per year for up to four years
Spring Semester Intake: Two awards; \$5000 per year for up to four years (September deadline)

THE MERIT SCHOLARSHIP - \$5,000

Eligibility **New for 2020 * Interim transcripts due: February 20, 2020** Applications due: April 6, 2020

- a) enrolling in any KPU program
- b) 80% average in English Studies 12 and 3 other academic Grade 12 courses, or the equivalent of a 3.67 transfer GPA on a minimum of 24 transferable university credits
- c) demonstrated leadership, community involvement and volunteerism

Conditions

- a) registration in a minimum of 12 undergraduate credits per semester
- b) required to maintain a minimum CGPA of 3.0 for the duration of the award period

Value & Quantity

Fall Semester Intake: 12 awards; \$5000 split over 2 terms in first year
Spring Semester Intake: Six awards; \$5000 split over 2 terms in first year (September deadline)

THE INDIGENOUS ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIP - \$5,000

Eligibility **New for 2020 * Interim transcripts due: February 20, 2020** Applications due: April 6, 2020

- a) must identify as Aboriginal, First Nations, Metis or Inuit
- b) 80% average in English Studies 12 and 3 other academic Grade 12 courses, or the equivalent of a 3.67 transfer GPA on a minimum of 24 transferable university credits
- d) demonstrated leadership, community involvement and volunteerism

Conditions

- a) registration in a minimum of 12 undergraduate credits per semester
- b) required to maintain a minimum CGPA of 3.0 for the duration of the award period

Value & Quantity

Fall Semester Intake: Two awards; \$5000 split over 2 terms in first year
Spring Semester Intake: One award; \$5000 split over 2 terms in first year (September deadline)



MAJOR ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIPS

Required Academic Documentation

- High school transcript showing final and/or interim grades for English 12 and three other academic Grade 12 courses, or
- Transfer document showing equivalent of a 3.67 transfer GPA on a minimum of 24 transferable university credits.

Required Supporting Documentation

Students Out of High School for 2 Years or Less

- Minimum one reference letter from a High School counsellor, teacher or principal supporting the application, AND minimum one reference letter to support community involvement, leadership or volunteer activities.

Students Out of High School for More Than 2 Years

- Minimum two reference letters, from independent sources, to support recent community involvement, leadership or volunteer activities.

DONOR-FUNDED ENTRANCE AWARDS

Required Academic Documentation

High school transcript showing final and/or interim grades for four Grade 12 courses, one of which must be English 12 and one other academic Grade 12 course.

Required Supporting Documentation Applicable to All Students

Reference letters as noted for Major Entrance Scholarships, a Student Statement or Essay (if stated in criteria), and a [Budget Worksheet](#) if financial need is noted in the award.
